Grass Cutting Schedule

Monthly schedule of grass cutting 2024-2026

The area to be cut as required between April and October. Grass height should be maintained at a height of 35-50mm between cuts.

Mowing will be to the full area of grass on the sites and up to any paving, fencing or boundary. Grass around obstacles will be cut to the same height, frequency and standard as surrounding area. Cuttings to be removed from the sites.

Site specific requirements noted below:

APRIL, MAY, JUNE, JULY, AUGUST, SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER

- Swinsty Bus Shelter (on right hand side when entering the village from Wigton)
Cut all the grassed area surrounding the bus shelter and remove any weeds from the bus shelter.
- The Memorial Garden
Cut all the grassed area either side of the memorial garden and adjoining grassed area around the corner.
- The Playground/Outdoor Gym
Cut the full area of the playground/Outdoor Gym. Remove any weeds from rubber safety mats.

Additional requirements noted below:

1. The front roadside hedge at the allotment – 2 cuts April and September.
2. Strim and cut back branches and overhanging thorns from the public alleyways leading into Friars Garth – April, June, August and October
3. Weed killer to be applied to weeded areas on Community Sports Pavilion car park, coal yard seated area, entrance to Friars Garth including all alleyways and the memorial garden.
